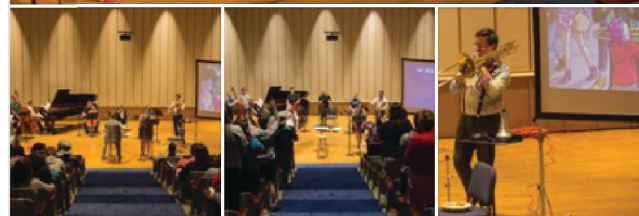

"Performances of the work have each been an overwhelming success due to the incorporation of visual art elements, multiple musical genres, and a narrative that is appealing to all ages," said Russ Zokaite, a visiting professor in the Morehead State University music department and director of the project.

The faculty showcase is the third time this piece has been performed and previous performances have been well received, said Zokaite.

George "specializes in the use of mixed media to blur the distinctions between concert performance, installation art, and theater." Her music, performance art and installations have made international and domestic premieres in England, Hong Kong, Austria, the Netherlands and the east and west coast of the U.S.

The group plans to perform the piece again at the International Trombone Festival,

July 4-10 at Ball State University in Muncie, Indiana.



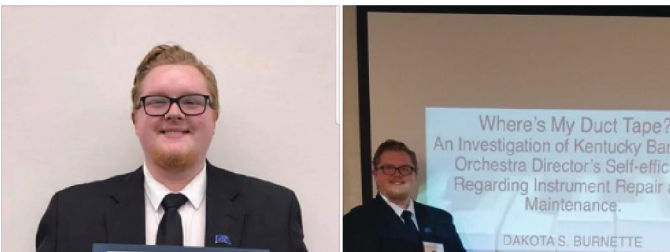

Today I presented my research study that I was conducting for the Undergraduate Research Fellowship and the Art of Music Teaching Fellowship at Morehead State. My study was entitled, "Where's My Duct Tape? An Investigation of Kentucky Band and Orchestra Director's Self-efficacy with Regard to Instrument Repair and Maintenance."

Although that may sound boring, this was an area that I wanted to explore. My study has been an ongoing project since September and has absolutely consumed my time, pushed me incredibly hard, and proved to be very difficult. So, I just wanted to thank my Research Supervisor, Dr. DuWayne Dale for being such an incredible mentor through this whole process, guiding me through my research, and providing some good laughs even when I wanted to pull my hair out (almost) every Monday at 11 a.m.; Dr. Michele Paynter Paise for being somewhat of a secondary mentor, just an overall great faculty member, and wonderful human being; and finally, my beautiful girlfriend Sarah Hamilton for always encouraging and supporting me through all of this.
